2017-2018 MBBS ADMISSIONS

BEFORE ADMISSIONS

- All advertisements related to admissions to the fresh batch of MBBS students contained the punishment for indulging in any sort of ragging
- The brochure / prospectus provided with Ant ragging regulations in Block letters including annexures. The 'Prospectus' and other admission related documents has incorporated with all directions of the Hon'ble Supreme Court and /or the Central or State Governments as applicable,
- An undertaking stating the consequences of indulging in ragging taken from both the candidate and the Parents at the time of admission
- The student seeking admission in the Hostel also has signed the undertaking – Annexure I – Part I & II.
- Placed posters in strategic places like Academic block, Canteen, Library, Hostel, common room etc. to create awareness about the stringent Anti-Ragging laws.
- Anti-Ragging squad has been constituted by including following members ; Faculty , Wardens , Chief Security officer , Canteen Manager , House Keeping Manager , Librarian.

ON ADMISSIONS

- Every fresher has been provided with the pamphlet with the names and contact details of all members of the Anti-Ragging Committee and the anti-ragging Squad, District, Police and university authorities. The Pamphlet also included the timeline of all major events and holidays in the next academic year
- A Counselling Cell by Including Psychiatrists Dr. Sharadha , Assoc. Prof. , Dept. of Psychiatry and Dr. Vinu Prasad , Asst. prof. Dept. of Psychiatry .
- A Joint fresher's day function has been proposed in the Last week October 2017.
- Freshers are encouraged to report any incident of ragging or as a witness to any such incident
- Freshers are divided into small groups and each group is assigned to a faculty member during the moments within the campus.
- Separate entrance is being provided for the freshers at the hostel and different timings has been fixed for MESS in the hostel.
