INSTRUCTIONS TO CANDIDATES

Candidates who receive allotment shall have to take a printout of their allotment memo and remit the fee/ balance fee payable to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations by way of Online Payment from 19.08.2017 to 24.08.2017. The State Bank of India (SBI) account holders can remit the requisite fee in one of the designated branches of State Bank of India (SBI) through Cheque Payment. The list of designated branches of SBI is available on the website.

The fee can also be paid by way of Demand Draft (DD) drawn in favour of Commissioner for Entrance Examinations, payable at Thiruvananthapuram. In case of payment by way of DD, the original Demand Draft should be submitted to the Office of the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations, Thiruvananthapuram and a payment receipt will be issued to the candidates from the Office of the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations. After remitting the fee/balance fee in any of the methods above, the candidates should join the course/college allotted in the second phase, before 5 pm on 24.08.2017.

Note: All the fees shown above are 'provisional' and will be subject to variation/enhancement as will be decided by the Hon'ble High Court in various Writ Petitions pending before it. The students getting allotment shall be liable to satisfy the deficit, if the fee gets enhanced by the Hon'ble High Court/AFRC.

Candidates getting allotment to Self Financing Medical/Dental Colleges in the second phase of allotment shall have to remit the entire fee for the year to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations on or before the last date notified for joining the colleges.

The vacant seats in MBBS/BDS courses remaining after the second phase of allotment will be filled up through a Spot Admission to be conducted by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations. Candidates getting allotment in the Spot Admission shall have to remit the entire fee for the year to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations then and there, at the venue of the Spot Admission.

Candidates are requested to watch for notifications that will be issued after in pursuant to Court Orders and Government Orders to get updated in the process of allotment.
