In pursuance of decision of the 1st Appeal Committee, NMC dated **24.10.2024** (which has already been communicated to you through e-mail by Policy and Coordination Division, NMC), Medical Assessment and Rating Board (MARB) is conveying you the final order **for starting of new PG course MD - Dermatology Venerology and Leprosy with Two (02) seats at P K Das Institute of Medical Sciences, Palakkad, Kerala, for Academic Year: 2024-25.**

2. It is to inform you that your institution is fully responsible to fulfil and maintain norms including the infrastructure both physical and human resources, teaching faculty, clinical material and stipend to PG students similar to PG students of government colleges in the state etc. throughout the academic year, as stipulated in regulation of National Medical Commission (NMC).

3. In case of false/wrong declaration or fabricated documents have been used for procuring permissions of MARB and any misconduct is brought to the notice of National Medical Commission (NMC) or **found**

during surprise assessment at any stage during the current academic year, your institution is liable, not to be considered for recognition of that degree. This letter of permission will be revoked for the current academic year if such exigency arises. Besides, National Medical Commission (NMC) is entitled to take all such measure against you and your college/institution as permissible under the law.

4. It is mandatory by government medical colleges to contribute **15%** MBBS seats and **50%** of post graduate broad specialties (MD/MS) for All India Quota respectively, to MCC of DGHS for conduction of counselling as per the directions of Hon'ble Supreme Court.

5. It is mandatory to develop a website of medical college/institution and display all the information of college and courses offered as per the guidelines issued by National Medical Commission (NMC) from time to time.

6. This has approval of the Competent Authority.
