ORDER

Vide paper (1) read above, the University had invited applications from affiliated colleges for granting Provisional Affiliation for the academic year 2025-26.

In response to the above notification, the Principals of the following medical colleges submitted their applications for granting Consent of Affiliation for the enhancement of MBBS course for the academic year 2025-26, vide paper (2) read above.

University conducted inspection and the reports submitted by the Inspection Commission were scrutinized by the Scrutiny Committee and recommended to grant Consent of Affiliation for the enhancement of seats in MBBS course, vide paper read (3 & 4) above.

Accordingly, the University issued Consents of Affiliation to the above mentioned medical colleges for the enhancement of seats in MBBS course for the academic year 2025-26, vide paper (5) read above.

Vide paper (6) read above, on receipt of the Letter of Permission from the National Medical Commission, the Principals of the above mentioned colleges submitted applications for Provisional Affiliation for the enhancement of seats in MBBS course for the academic year 2025-26.

Vide papers (7 & 8) read above, the University has conducted final inspections at these colleges, and the reports of the Inspection Commission received from the institutions were scrutinized by the Scrutiny Committee. The Scrutiny Committee recommended granting Provisional Affiliation for the enhancement of seats in MBBS course with the intake mentioned against each, as shown in the table below, for the academic year 2025-26.

The matter of granting Provisional Affiliation to the above mentioned colleges was placed before the Subcommittee of the Governing Council, and the Committee recommended granting Provisional Affiliation for starting the MBBS courses for the academic year 2025-26, vide paper (9) read above.

Since the name of the Medical Colleges had to be forwarded to CEE and DME urgently for the allotment, based on the recommendation of the Subcommittee of the Governing Council, the Hon'ble Vice Chancellor granted Provisional Affiliation to the above mentioned medical colleges for starting the MBBS course with the intake mentioned above for the academic year 2025-26, subject to ratification by the Governing Council.

Accordingly, the University forwarded the names of the medical colleges to the CEE and DME for considering these colleges in the allotment process for the academic year 2025-26.

The matter has been placed before the 86th meeting of the Governing Council and Governing Council has resolved to ratify the action of the Hon'ble Vice Chancellor in having granted Provisional Affiliation for Enhancement of the seats in MBBS course in above mentioned medical colleges and forwarding the same to DME/CEE, vide paper read (10) above.

Accordingly, orders are hereby issued granting Provisional Affiliation to the above mentioned medical colleges for the enhancement of seats in MBBS course with the intake mentioned against each for the academic year 2025-26.

In addition to the above, the college shall satisfy the conditions detailed below:

- Selection, Admission and collection of fees shall be made only on the basis of the rules and regulations of the University/Govt. of Kerala and on the basis of the direction issued by the University/Govt. of Kerala from time to time, failing which the affiliation granted will be cancelled.
- In the light of the direction of the Supreme Court of India in Writ Petition(c) 656/1998, the institution shall take appropriate measures for prevention of ragging in any form. In case of failure to prevent the instances of ragging, appropriate action including withdrawal of affiliation of the College will be initiated.
- Affiliation granted is strictly provisional and only for the academic year 2025-26. The college has to apply for continuation of provisional affiliation for the ensuing years remitting the fee fixed by the University, along with a copy of letter of approval from the apex bodies concerned.
- Admission to the next academic year shall be done only after obtaining prior permission from the University. The College should collect fees (one-time payment at the time of admission) from the students to be remitted to the University as follows:
